It is the mission of EVC's NATP (Nurse Assistant Training Program) to prepare students to become competent, confident, responsible, and compassionate caregivers and contribute to the well-being of those under their care.

1. Identify the roles and responsibilities of the CNA and HHA, including maintaining client rights, protecting confidentiality, and recognizing, preventing, and reporting abuse.
2. Demonstrate skills necessary to perform nursing assistant and home health aide procedures safely and effectively, including infection control procedures, emergency procedures, proper body mechanics, accurate measurement of vital signs and intake/output, mobility/transfer techniques, grooming/hygiene principles, feeding techniques, therapeutic communication, and accurate documentation.
3. Analyze appropriate client interventions taken by nursing assistants or home health aides based on human anatomy, normal changes in aging, and the medical/social needs of the clients being served.
4. Explain nutrition concepts and cleaning/care tasks in the home setting as it pertains to the role of the home health aide.
